The purposes of the corporation are:

1. to represent, promote and advance the interests of residents and ratepayers of York Mills Heights in the City of Toronto as delineated in the by-laws of the corporation from time to time (the "Area");
2. to preserve and improve the community, social, cultural and recreational interests and quality of life within the Area as a residential area and the welfare of the residents of the Area;
3. to advocate on behalf of its members and engage at all levels of government, to inform residents of the Area of existing and pending legislation, by-laws, ordinances and other governmental regulations and policy affecting the Area and to submit briefs, petitions and requests to all levels of government on matters affecting the Area;
4. to assist in the preparation, promulgation and execution of legislation, by-laws, ordinances and other governmental regulations and policy designed to advance the interests of residents and ratepayers of the Area;
5. to take whatever steps appear to the corporation to be necessary or desirable to support or oppose proposed changes in land use that may affect the Area, including participation in proceedings before all levels of government, including without limitation City Council, the Committee of Adjustment, the Toronto Local Appeal Board, the Ontario Land Tribunal, and the Lieutenant-Governor in Council;
6. to maintain liaison with and co-operate with other associations of ratepayers or residents in the City of Toronto and elsewhere
