To all to whom these Presents shall come
Greeting

Whereas *The Corporations Act provides that with the exceptions therein mentioned the Lieutenant Governor may in his discretion, by Letters Patent, issue a Charter to any number of persons, not fewer than three, of ~~twenty-one~~ ^{eighteen} or more years of age, who apply therefor, constituting them and any others who become shareholders or members of the corporation thereby created a corporation for any of the objects to which the authority of the Legislature extends;*

And Whereas *by the said Act it is further provided that the member of the Executive Council to whom the administration of this Act is assigned may in his discretion and under the Seal of his office have, use, exercise and enjoy any power, right or authority conferred by the said Act on the Lieutenant Governor;*

And Whereas *it has been made to appear that the persons herein named have complied with the conditions precedent to the issue of the desired Charter and that the said undertaking is within the scope of the said Act;*

Now Therefore Know Ye *that, being the member of the Executive Council to whom the administration of this Act is assigned, I do by these Letters Patent issue a Charter to the Persons hereinafter named that is to say:*

Broker; all of The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto,
in the Province of Ontario; constituting them and any others
who become members of the Corporation hereby created a corporation
without share capital under the name of

YORK MILLS HEIGHTS RATEPAYERS ASSOCIATION

for the following objects, that is to say:

- (a) TO take an active interest and participate in the civic,
political, commercial and social affairs and activities

(b) TO represent and advance the position of the York Mills Heights area of the Borough of North York before federal, provincial, municipal and other governmental authorities and to participate in any hearings or proceedings before such authorities, to retain legal counsel and any other person necessary to the attainment of this object;

(c) TO provide a forum for the full and free discussion of all matters of public and community interest;

(d) TO hold conferences and other meetings for the discussion of social problems and the exchange of views relating to municipal, provincial and federal government;

(e) TO collect monies by way of fees, donations or otherwise and to accept gifts, legacies, devises and bequests, and to hold, invest, expend, contribute or deal with the same in furtherance of the objects of the Corporation; and

(f) TO do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects;

THE HEAD OFFICE of the Corporation to be situate in the Borough of North York, in the said The Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto; and

THE FIRST DIRECTORS of the Corporation to be John Gordon Sinclair,

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Edwin Wilfred McDougald, John David Cairns, Joseph James Heffernen, Joel Grant Sinclair, James Thomas Clinkard, Jeremy George Nairn Johnston, Thomas Frederick Stevens Brown, Marianna Gignac, Genevieve Hanley, Robert Buchanan Mauchan, Denis Malachy Newman, David Edmund Wragge Pinkham and Robert Jamieson Rowland, hereinbefore mentioned;

AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND DECLARED that the Corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the Corporation shall be used in promoting its objects;

AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDAINED AND DECLARED that, upon the dissolution of the Corporation and after the payment of all debts and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed or disposed of to charitable organizations which carry on their work solely in Canada;

AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDAINED AND DECLARED that the

no director shall directly or indirectly receive any profit from his position as such; provided that a director may be paid reasonable expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties.
